Why is encouragement necessary?

2 Timothy 3:1. GNB
The word literally means
"No officer shall speak discouragingly to another officer in the discharge of his duties" (Royal Navy Regulations)
"You have taught many people and given strength to feeble hand: When someone stumbled, weak and tired Your words encouraged him to stand" (Eliphaz to Job in Job 4:4. GNB)
What is encouragement?
The Greek word 'to encourage' is; with connected words it appears in the New Testament. It literally means "to call alongside".
From the same root comes which Jesus uses to describe the Holy Spirit (see John 14:16,26; 15;26; 16:7.).
It can be translated Helper, Comforter, Counsellor, Encourager or Advocate.
So, we could translate Hebrews 10:25,
"Let us be like the Holy Spirit to one another".
